With the redesign we increased conversion rates as well as better explained our key features which boosted subscriptions. They currently have over 1000 subscribers. I also did graphic design work on elements of the product such as the game manual and box cover art.

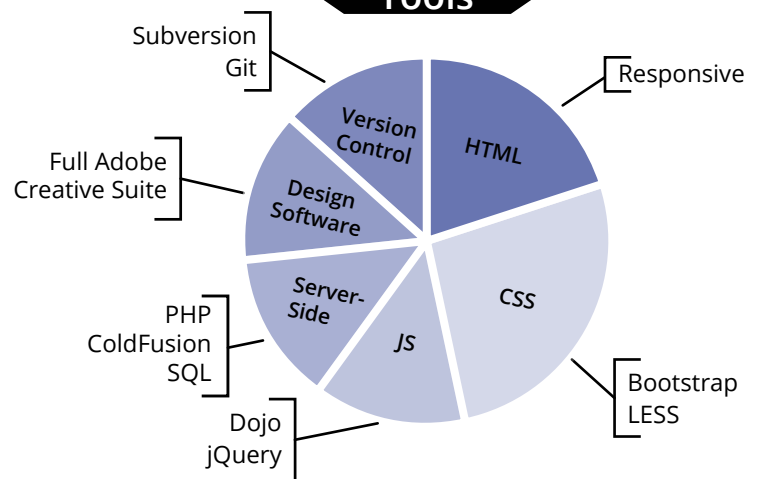
### Software Engineer I at Northrop Grumman [September 2014 - Present]
